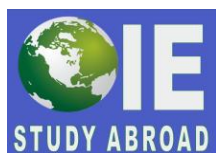


STATUS AND CREDITS WHILE ABROAD

- While abroad, students will remain registered at IUP (computer accounts remain active, students can register while abroad, etc.) just like they are here on campus.
- Students earn **Transfer credit** and all IUP study abroad programs, meaning they will maintain their degree progress however, their **GRADES** will not be counted in the GPA.
- **Faculty-led programs** each have a specific academic focus, and will therefore required all participants to enroll directly in the IUP course(s) taught on the program.
- **All other study abroad programs** offer courses instructed by another academic institution. Students are enrolled in an IUP placeholder course while they are overseas. The IUP Office of Transfer Services will work with students to establish IUP course equivalencies for each of the courses the student has completed abroad.
 - **Students applying to participate in Exchange or Partnership programs** are required to meet with you, as part of the application process, to talk about what classes they can or cannot take abroad and what requirements they need to fulfill. You may be required to sign an Academic Advising Form before the student will be accepted to their program.
 - Check out the transfer credit equivalency website for courses that students have taken in the past. Students can print this list of pre-established course equivalencies and take it to you for review. If there is a course listed that your advisee needs to take you can write it on the Academic Advising Form. Not all classes are listed here. If you do not see what your advisee needs to take, have him or her talk to the credit evaluator in the IUP Office of Transfer Services about other courses that may be available.
