Who Can Go Abroad?

- **Sophomores, Juniors & Seniors**
- **GPA requirement: 2.5***
- **All majors are eligible**

***Some programs require a 3.0 GPA**

Crimson Programs

Exchange

- Enroll directly at an institution
- IUP receives exchange student
- Take classes with students in host country
- Semester or full year option
- Near the cost of IUP tuition

Direct

- Enroll directly at an institution
- Take classes with students in host country
- Summer, semester, full year options
- Billed host institution's fees through IUP

Program Providers

CEA • ISEP • SAI • Semester-at-Sea

- Enroll in program courses affiliated with university
- Take classes with other American students
- Credits transfer, grades do not
 - Passing = C- or better
- Summer, semester, full year options
- This program cost is billed through IUP – but you pay the cost set by that provider. Not the same tuition as IUP.
 - Prices vary – some more affordable than IUP tuition, others less so
 - Financial aid, scholarships apply (cannot use BOG or tuition waiver)



Faculty-Led

- Enrolled in IUP courses
 - May take class(es) prior to departure, or while abroad
- Take classes with other IUP students
- Credits **AND** grades transfer
- Summer, winter options
- IUP course fees and associated costs
 - Meals, housing, travel, excursions
 - Financial aid, scholarships may apply
 - May use tuition waiver for tuition portion only, not program fees



Independently Arranged

- You'll work with our office
- Different program we don't offer
- PASSHE visiting student
- Direct enroll abroad
- We'll keep you enrolled as an IUP student*

*must meet all criteria

National Student Exchange



- Semester or year
- US, Canada, US Virgin Islands, Puerto Rico, Guam
- Credits transfer, grades do not
- Why study in a different state?
 - Take classes not available at IUP
- Network:
 - Internships
 - Graduate school
 - Research & Field Study

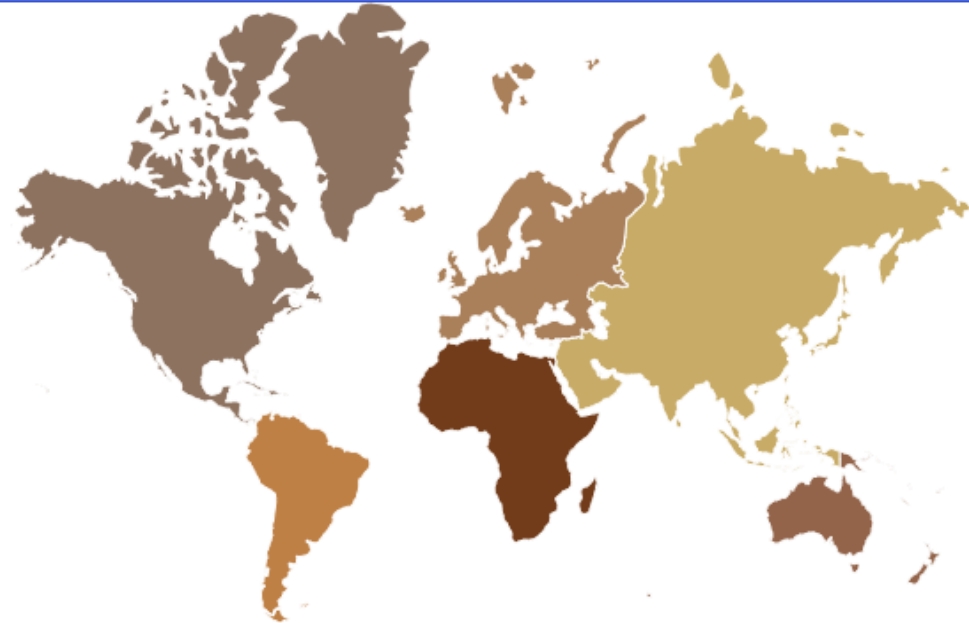


Map Search





Top ranked, Korea University is one of the oldest and largest in the country. The university's reputation for teaching, research and service to Korean study is acknowledged throughout the country. The university is located in the small town of Jochiwon which is only a short bus ride from three major cities. Check out this [promotional video](#) to learn more about the campus.

Korea University Sejong **offers a scholarship** to cover the housing and meal plan (2 meals a day) for any student who signs up to room with Korean students and work with them each day on English. Also, for students who study for a semester, they will reimburse you for your airfare (up to \$1,200.) See your study abroad advisor for details.

Faculty-Led

\$ IUP tuition and fees according to student status*

Program costs are listed by the Faculty-leader.

The typical inclusions are: meals, lodging, in-country travel, excursions

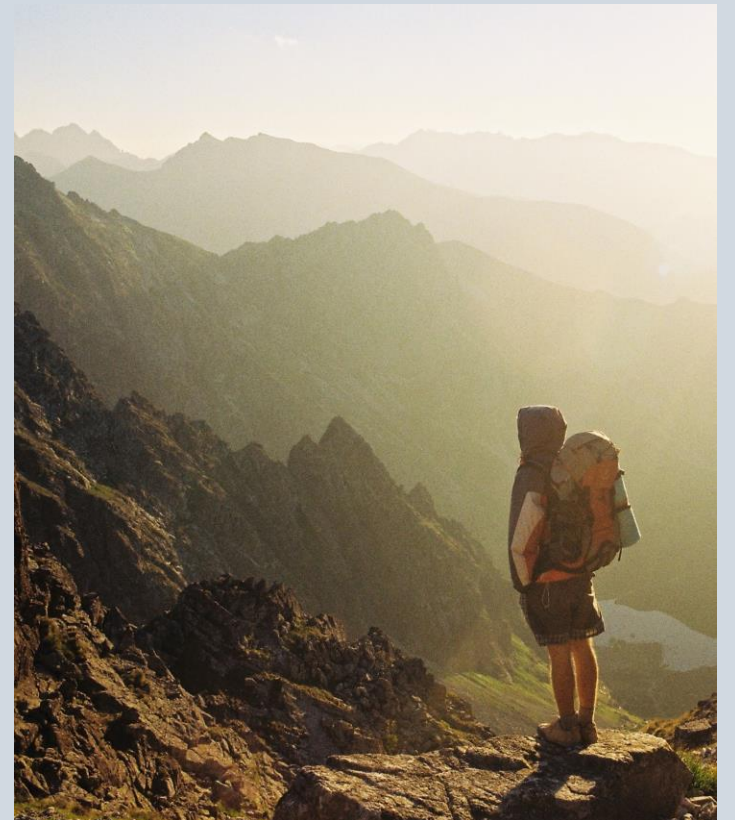
